Nonresident Student Enrollment Capacity

USD 241 will have limited capacity to accept nonresident students for the 2025-2026 school year. Based on the projected enrollment and capacity to operate effectively, USD 241 will accept nonresident students as outlined in the table below. The district reserves the right to assign nonresident students to a school and the process for selection is outlined below. Students living outside of the USD 241 boundary must formally apply for nonresident enrollment and use the application linked below which will be available on or before June 1, 2025. The completed application must be received by no later than June 15, 2025. However, nonresident students wanting to be considered for enrollment may submit an application at any time during the school year. Applications may also be picked up and returned to the USD 241 District Office at 521 N Main, Sharon Springs, KS.
